Leila Gobi est originaire de la lointaine ville provinciale de Menaka dans le Sahel Malien, elle est maintenant devenue une artiste reconnue et respectée à Bamako, la capitale.

Après un premier album et une tournée aux USA en 2015, elle sort aujourd'hui son deuxième album intitulé "2017", produit et édité par Christopher NOLAN du label newyorkais « Clermont ». Avec ce nouvel opus, le son touareg entre dans une nouvelle dimension tout en restant fidèle aux racines sous-jacentes de cette musique. Elle se teinte de sons electros et contemporains qui ne seraient rien sans la puissance de ce répertoire de transe originelle qui sert de guide à ses boucles hypnotiques. La voix iconique et brillante de Leila s'impose dans ce nouvel univers ponctué de chœurs d'hommes et de guitares puissantes.

Le son créé à Bamako, masterisé et mixé à Los Angeles et New-York, sera recomposé sur scène par Leila accompagnée par 3 musiciens Maliens et un DJ occidental.
